

Minutes of Regular Meeting
Mayor and Council
City of Fitzgerald, Georgia
July 9, 2018
6:00 pm

Mayor and Council of the City of Fitzgerald, Georgia, met in a **Regular** meeting in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 302 East Central Avenue, with Mayor Pro Tem Griffin presiding and with Council members Coney, Jefferson, Johnson, Roberts, Tillman, Webb and Williams being present.

Minutes of June 11, 2018, Regular Council meeting were read. Mayor Pro Tem Griffin entertained a motion for approval. Council Person Williams made a motion to approve minutes, seconded by Council Person Coney. Having a motion and a second, Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked if there were any additions or corrections. With none being heard, called for a **Roll Call Vote: 7 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.**

Mayor Pro Tem Griffin welcomed Wendell Thompson. Mr. Thompson asked to speak. Mr. Thompson spoke on the need for consolidation with emphasis on the combining of our Police and Sheriff departments.

Under reports of city officers, reports were given by their respective chair person. Mayor Pro Tem Griffin called attention too many calendar items that will occur prior to our next scheduled council meeting. He asked if there were any questions of the department heads and with none moved to Ordinances and Resolutions.

Mayor Pro Tem Griffin called on Counselor Kyle Cook.

City Attorney, Kyle Cook, presented **Resolution R18-009-A**, an amended resolution noting effective contract dates for the contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Human Services to provide afterschool care services through the Monitor Enrichment Program. Council Person Coney motioned to dispense with full reading, seconded by council Person Roberts. Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked if there was any discussion. With none heard, moved to **Roll Call Vote: 7 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.**

Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked for approval of **Resolution R18-009-A**. Council Person Coney motioned to approve the amended resolution, seconded by Council Person Webb. Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked if there was any discussion and with none, moved to **Roll Call Vote: 7 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.**

City Attorney, Kyle Cook, presented the following Ordinance Captions:

Ordinance Caption to close vehicular and pedestrian traffic a portion of that certain public road known as Stuart Way in the City of Fitzgerald, Ben Hill County, Georgia.

Ordinance Caption to amend Chapter 12, "Garbage, Trash and Weeds" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fitzgerald, Georgia.

Under New Business: Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked for consideration to reappoint Anna Brown to the Fitzgerald, Ben Hill County Library Board. Council Person Johnson motioned to accept this reappointment seconded by Council Person Coney. Mayor Pro Tem Griffin asked if there was any discussion. With none, called for **Roll Call Vote: 7 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.**

Council Person Coney thanked the Mayor Pro Tem for his leadership during this council meeting.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
